Measured

- Exams are now terminal – at the end of year 11 so departments will be organising courses to allow for revision time in Y11
- Year 10 is the last full teaching year – so every minute matters
- Attendance is critical – Government data has shown that pupils with no absence are 1.5 times more likely to achieve 5+ GCSEs A* - C or equivalent and 2.8 times more likely to achieve 5+ GCSEs A*- C or equivalent including English and mathematics than pupils missing 15 – 20 per cent of KS4 lessons.
