... and those are the section you need to revise for the mock examination. You should use only the relevant parts of the following resources.

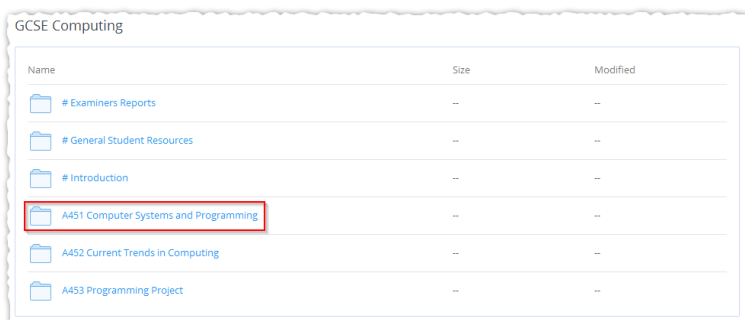
Past examination papers

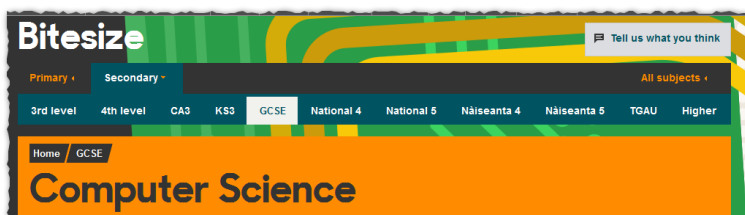

The fully revamped BBC Bitesize website gives you access to revision notes and tests for each section of the course. Only revise the section you have been instructed to complete.

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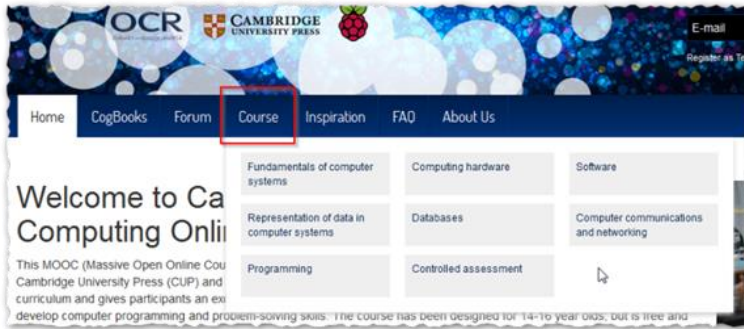
